# Adxstudio Portals



xRM

- Introduce MVC based features and helpers

Portals v6 on  
CRM 2013/2011

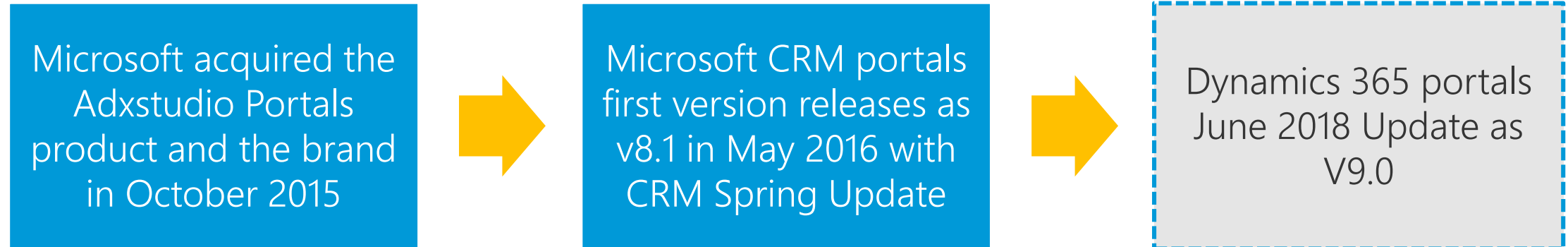
- Move to a single code base called MasterPortal
- Moved to late bound instead of early bound/strong types
- Entity Form, Entity List introduced
- Bootstrap introduced for responsive design

Portals v7 on  
CRM  
2015/2013

- Liquid Templates
- ASP.NET Identity replaced ASP.NET CRM Contact Membership Provider
- Supports CRM 2016 and now Dynamics 365 with CRM SDK 6.1.2

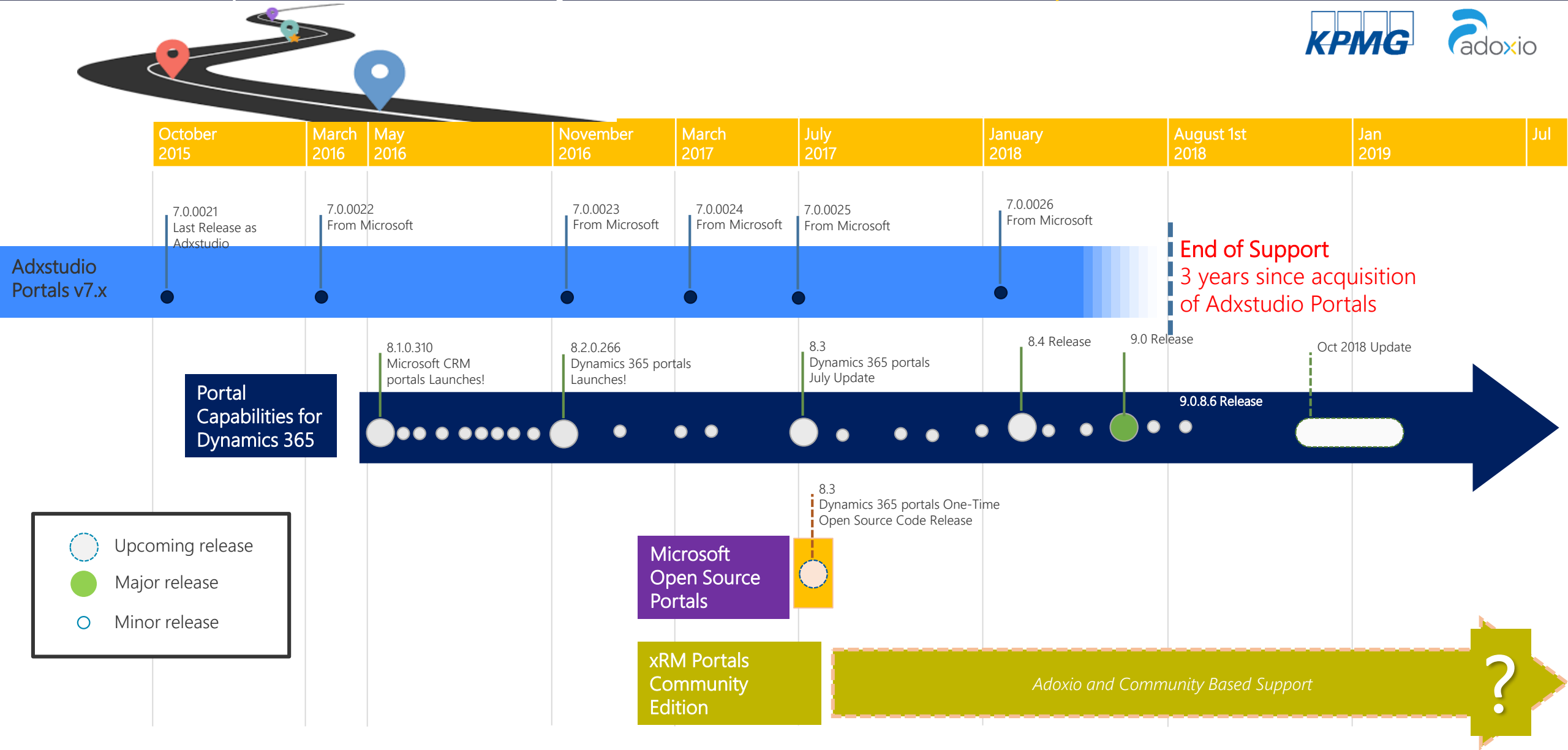


# Dynamics 365 Portals, from Microsoft



- Only released as Software as a Service
- No on premise or self hosted version
  - Microsoft hosted portals on Azure
  - No MasterPortal code access – no .NET Framework, no CRM SDK, no C#
  - Limits the customization options compared to previous versions of Adxstudio Portals

# What are my Options?



## Migrate to Dynamics 365 Portal Capabilities

- Only viable long term option
- New enhancements
- New Features
- Monthly releases
- Supported by Microsoft
- Dynamics 365 Online Only

## Migrate to 8.3 Open Source Code

- Suited as a stepping version before upgrading to CRM Portals
- No support
- No updates, bug fixes and Patch
- Self Hosted

## Migrate to xRM Portals Community Edition

- Short Term stepping version prior to upgrading to CRM Portals
- Bug Fixes by Adoxio and Dynamics community
- Supported by Adoxio
- Self Hosted

## Continue using Adxstudio Portals

- If you have perpetual license
- Might not be supported on future releases of Dynamics 365
- No support
- No updates, bug fixes and Patch
- Self Hosted

# Upgrade Options & Method



- How was your Adxstudio Portal was Implemented
  - Code Customization (Application code changes)  
Vs Configuration
  - Features used
    - Unsupported Portal Template
    - SharePoint
    - Shopping Cart
    - Payment Handling



# Upgrade Methods



## Microsoft Whitepaper

- Documented Portal Migration Procedure
- Released in Feb 2018
- Provides two options:
  - Reimplementation
    - Does not provide tool /step for reimplementation
  - Migration
    - Migration using Open source Portal code

## Reimplement

- Reimplement functionality in Dynamics 365

## Migration using PowerShell scripts

- Migrate to 8.3 Open Source Code as Intermediary
- In Place Migration

## Upgrade using Data Migration Tools

- Migrate using third-party Data Migration Tools
- Migration to Dynamics 365 Portals
- Options: SSIS, Scribe, Informatica etc.



# Portal Migration using Data Migration Tools



- Portal data structure/model changes between Adxstudio portals & Dynamics 365 portals capabilities.
- Current migration scripts is still data dependent to get it right.
- Data migration tools gives greater control on the process.
- Migration scripts can be used to facilitate upgrade from unsupported template to supported template.



# Data Migration using SSIS & KingswaySoft



## SQL Server Integration Service(SSIS)

- ✓ Enterprise data integration, data transformation and data migration tool by Microsoft
- ✓ Allows Data Transformation in transit
- ✓ Tightly integrated with Microsoft Visual Studio and SQL Server.
- ✓ Better for complex transformations, multi-step operations, aggregating data from different data sources or types, and structured exception handling.

## SSIS Integration Toolkit by KingswaySoft

- ✓ SSI connection Adopters for Dynamics 365
- ✓ Works with all Dynamics 365 deployment types

SSIS & KingswaySoft Adopter : One of the best tool for migrating data from Legacy apps to Dynamics 365





# Upgrade Prep : Identify Customizations



## Identify : Application/code Customization

- Remove customization and plan for reimplementing using configuration
- General code customization examples are:
  - Custom code/Aspx pages
  - Custom MVC Project
  - Modifications to the OOB Code(MasterPages modification ).

## Identify : unsupported features

- Remove dependency on unsupported features
  - Remove webpage and weblink references to event, issues, articles.

## Backup:

- Backup before starting on migration process
- Perform Migration on a Sandbox



# Upgrade Prep : How to deal with unsupported components



Reimplement code customization in supported format:

- Use liquid templates where possible

Unsupported Features from Adxstudio Portals & custom code:

- Consider Portal companion App(Portal buddy)
- Consider Connect 365



# Upgrade Prep : Environment Prep



Create a Sandbox  
copy of Dynamics 365  
Instance

Uninstall all Adxstudio  
portals solutions  
completely on the  
Sandbox

Install the Dynamics  
365 portal solutions  
from Applications

Setup and configure  
Dynamics 365 portal  
based on original  
portal used

Validate portal  
content data and  
delete/deactivate  
those you don't need,  
example blogs,  
forums.

Adxstudio Portal Upgrade-Migration using SSIS

# Post Upgrade : Validation



Disable custom errors on Dynamics portal

Enable diagnostic logging

Validate Styling and adjust to be Dynamics 365 Portals compatible

Complete regression testing

Test, validate and deactivate pages you aren't using in implementation.



# Data Migration using SSIS



Stater Package:

<https://github.com/kunaltripathy/Dynamics365SSISPackages/tree/master/AdxstudioPortalsMigration>

Benefits :

- Could be used as Starter Package for Portal Migration.
- Package allows remapping Adxstudio Portals data to CRM Portals structure.
- One package for Complete Portal Migration.
- Supports Migration from Unsupported Portals.
- Not an In place migration.
- Migrates comments to new Feedback Entity.
- Sets scope to Access Control Rules.
- Migrates Deactivated webpages as Deactivated Webpages.
- Removes spaces from partial url.
